

Rules and Etiquette:

- 1) The RCOS Car & Motorcycle Show starts at 6:00 PM and ends with trophy presentation at 7:30 PM
- 2) No obscene wording, drawings, photos will be allowed on a vehicle, sign or display area. You will be disqualified.
- 3) No questionable music and music will be kept to a reasonable level during the show.
- 4) No profanity.
- 5) No alcohol allowed.
- 6) Engines are not allowed to run at any time during the show. If the vehicle is started, you will be disqualified.
- 7) It is not mandatory, but highly recommended that you have a book with information and photos listing modifications and details that you want to emphasize.
- 8) Do not forget to abide by the fire marshal's regulations. Tape gas caps or have a locking gas cap.
- 9) During set-up and tear-down, reckless or careless driving and unnecessary noise will not be allowed.
- 10) JUDGING STAFF DECISIONS ARE FINAL!

*Please remember, you are in a public setting so conduct yourself accordingly. Do not discard your trash on the ground. Randolph County Old Settlers (RCOS) reserves the right to remove any promotional items within the display area.
